



Regulations regarding residual waste during GK4 races Karting Genk

Dear drivers, teams, supporters,

Environment - including decibels, pollution - is a major subject when it comes to operating a karting circuit. More and more rules are being imposed by the government.

Waste and how to deal with it can no longer be ignored during a karting weekend. All involved really have to make their positive contribution if we want to ensure the future of our beloved sport.

For example, that the waste collected/produced by a participant - including team, driver - during the eventweek must be taken with them. Nothing may be left behind when leaving the site.

Only tyres may be left in the designated place.

As a result of the high requirements and regulations imposed by the government and relevant authorities, we will have to impose the following rules on teams and drivers from this year.

- The places allocated to the teams and drivers are mapped out during the race weekend by means of a floor plan and photos. The teams are held responsible for the space obtained on the field.
- On arrival at the site and before setting up the place assigned to you, check this place. If you have any comments, please notify the trackmanager immediately.
- When you leave the site, take all your waste with you. You ensure that no piece of waste is left behind and that the place is left clean.
- Each team/.driver is responsible for his/her allocated space in the paddock.
- If dirt or contamination of the ground is found at the place assigned to them, after a team/.driver has left the terrain, an administrative fine of € 500.00 will be imposed on the team/.driver by Karting Genk.
- Inspection will take place on the day of leaving the site or the day after the event.

If you want to participate in a GK4 event you must comply with these rules.

We hope for good cooperation and assume that the team (owners) inform their drivers about these regulations and monitor their application.
